NOTIFICATION

No.58/2025/SEC

Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 03rd November, 2025.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub rule (1) of Rule 12 of Kerala Panchayat Raj (Conduct of Election) Rules, 1995 and the Kerala Municipality (Conduct of Election) Rules, 1995 and Paragraph 7 of the Local Authorities Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 2017 and in modification of the Notification No.09/2024/SEC dated 03.02.2024, published in the



Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.441 dated 05.02.2024, the State Election Commission, Kerala hereby publish an up- to-date list of election symbols, namely:-

- (i) The National Parties and the symbols respectively reserved to them, in Table I;
- (ii) The State Parties of Kerala and the symbols respectively reserved to them, in Table II;
- (iii) The State Parties of other States and Union Territories and Registered unrecognized Political Parties having member or members in the Kerala Legislative Assembly or having member or members in any of the Local Self Government Institutions in the State of Kerala and the symbols respectively allotted to them, in Table III;
- (iv) The candidates of Registered Unrecognized Political Parties, not coming under (i) to (iii) above shall be assigned symbols specifically shown in asterisk, from the list of free symbols, in Table IV, on priority basis;
- (v) Any other candidates, including independent candidates shall be given a symbol from the Table IV.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This does not form part of the Notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Sub-rule (1) of Rule 12 of the Kerala Panchayath Raj (Conduct of Election) Rules, 1995, provides that the State Election Commission shall, by notification in the Gazette, publish a list of symbols and may elaborate or alter them for the purpose of assigning symbols to the contesting candidates by the Returning Officer. For this purpose, State Election Commission as per Notification No.32/2025/SEC dated 19.09.2025 published a draft list of symbols by inviting claims and objections from political parties. Thereafter Commission considered each claim and objection received on the draft so published by giving notice to the political parties concerned and hearing them on 15.10.2025. Order FNo.56/Delisting/2025/PPS-III dated 19.09.2025 issued by Election Commission of India also considered by the State Election Commission before finalising the list. This list of symbols is issued for the purpose of assigning symbols to the contesting candidates come under different categories under Table I to IV by the Returning Officers in General Election to Local Self Government Institutions.

This Notification is intended to achieve the above object.
